More about Sen. Fulton:

Senator Tony Fulton was born and raised in Auburn, Nebraska. Though he studied philosophy and theology, Sen. Fulton ultimately received a B.S. in mechanical engineering from UNL in 1997. He was a Professional Engineer and worked at several companies, including Alvine Engineering. In 2003, he founded Guardian Angels Homecare, an organization dedicated to recognizing and celebrating the dignity of the human person by providing non-medical elder-care, thus allowing seniors to remain in their own homes. Initially appointed to the Nebraska Legislature in 2007, he was overwhelmingly elected to the position in 2008. Sen. Fulton serves on the Appropriations Committee. He is also a member of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers, and actively serves on various committees of the Lincoln Chamber of Commerce, the Better Business Bureau, the Lincoln Caregiver Education Group, and St. Peter's Catholic Church. Sen. Fulton and his wife Judy have six children.
