SUBJECT: 2004 National Election

As you are aware, the 2004 national election ended on Friday, August 13. The Tellers Committee convened on Tuesday, August 17, to verify the results. Consistent with the Bylaws, I am writing to give you formal notification of the results of this year's election.

President-elect Elect (2004-2005)

Dennis R. Martenson, P.E., F.ASCE

Martenson was elected with 56.1% of the vote. Martenson will be installed at the Society's annual business meeting on October 23, 2004, and will assume office as ASCE president in October 2005.

Governance Restructuring: Passed

The ballot initiative passed with 5,876 votes to approve, representing 78.7% of the votes cast. As a constitutional amendment, the measure required approval by a two-thirds majority of the total votes cast. The amendment adds Institute and At-Large Directors to the ASCE Board of Direction, reduces the overall size of the board and enables a regional structure.
